



### COMPETITION RULES

- Entry fee 50p per class.
- No exhibitor can enter more than one exhibit in a particular class.
- Bring your exhibits along to the marquee from 12.00pm to 1.30pm
- Judging will begin after 2pm.
- Results will be on the show day between 3:00pm and 4:00pm

#### VASE OF FLOWERS CATEGORIES

1. Annuals: Vase of 5 stems, one or more kinds
2. Sweet Peas: Vase of 9 stems, mixed colours
3. Dahlias: Vase of 3, one variety
4. Dahlias: Single specimen of medium, large or giant flowered (152mm diameter or more) leaves removed.

#### BOWL OF ROSES CATEGORIES

5. Bowl or container of 3 specimens of different large flowered type (Hybrid Tea)
6. 1 spray or cluster flowered (Floribunda)

#### CHILDREN COMPETITION = VEG HEAD/ORGANIC ANIMAL RULES

7. Any shape or size will do.
8. Only vegetables are allowed. No plastic props.

#### CAKES & BAKES (Our own Wrecclesham Bake off)

Cakes will be judged on Presentation, Taste and Texture:

#### NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS and JUDGES

- a. Entrant to supply vases but assistance will be available on the morning of the show.
- b. Only fresh, home, grown roses/flowers to be presented in the vase.
- c. No dried or silk flowers allowed.
- d. Exhibits are judged by RHS rules but the Judges have full discretion and judge according to the standard expected from a local village show.
- e. Flowering stems can be taken from any flowering plant.
- f. Judges may handle exhibits to check quality.
- g. Vases will be viewed from all directions.
